WHO SHOULD ATTEND & LOCATION

The *Wapakoneta Football Camp* is designed for students entering grades seven through nine next fall. The camp will be conducted on Wapakoneta's High School campus.

ABOUT THE CAMP

The *Wapakoneta Football Camp* provides instruction for all offensive and defensive positions. The Wapakoneta football staff will teach the basic fundamentals and emphasize individual techniques in order to develop better overall players and those that fit within the team concept.

Each camper will select an offensive and defensive position and split times of instruction for a well-rounded experience.

Quarterbacks: Each quarterback will receive emphasis on ball mechanics, proper footwork, stance and throwing the football. Passers will be instructed on the various drops and throwing positions.

Receivers/Tight Ends: Special emphasis will be on catching different types of passes, body position, pre-snap stance, releases and blocking as well as improving eye-hand coordination.

Running Backs: Each camper will learn proper fundamentals in the following areas: stance, handoff exchange, ball security, reading and using blockers, run blocking, pass protection, route running and pass receiving.

Offensive Line: Stance, types of run blocking and pass protection will be the major emphasis for campers. Drills to improve footwork, speed and quickness will be offered. Defensive Line: Each defensive lineman will work on stance, defeating run blocks, rushing the passer, tackling and other various techniques to enhance footwork and hand strength.

Linebackers: Each linebacker will be schooled on proper stance, offensive recognition, defeating blockers, tackling, man-to-man and zone pass defenses as well as ball skills. **Defensive Backs:** Members of the secondary will be exposed to all defensive techniques, including stance, backpedal, man-to-man coverage, tackling, zone defense and ball relationships.

The cost of the camp is \$40.00 per person and \$20 for any additional family member enrolled in this year's camp.
